### Description

This is a half-length portrait of a man, Lord MacDonnell. He is wearing a black jacket and a white shirt with a hard collar and a black tie. His order of the Grand Commander of the Star of India is on the right side of his jacket. His

arms are folded and resting on his knee. Yeats has rendered his distinctive moustache in reddish brown. William Orpen has also painted a portrait of Lord MacDonnell (see Object Number 43).
